Skill Up! is a Micro Credentialling program for Year 10 students aimed at building confidence in their transition to Stage 6 learning while also helping them develop greater self-efficacy for their future decision-making.

The program has three distinct micro credentials:

- Academic Literacies
- Building resilience through positive habits
- Future pathways planning


Within each micro credential, there are three modules designed to be completed within a 50 minute lesson.

Real Life Learning is a program designed to boost the connection between industry and schools. Real Life Learning uses the tasks people do at work in aged care everyday to open students' minds to the employment and education opportunities available in their communities.

There will be a mixture of school-based on aged-care based activities.

Using examples from aged care to demonstrate curriculum

Example class:

Students calculate the amount of supplement required to make a protein drink based on a resident's weight.

Curriculum: Identify everyday questions and issues involving at least one numerical and at least one categorical variable, and collect data directly and from secondary

sources (ACMSP228) eg comparing the annual rainfall in various parts of Australia, Pakistan and Malaysia Year 10 work experience, project work in senior years.

Students in 2-unit maths can calculate how much insulin to administer to a resident based on their Blood Glucose Level
